SCRIPTURE READING James 5:13-20 Pastors Gina and Jess

PRAYER OF CONFESSION based on 2 Corinthians 1:4-5

Pastor Gina

Leader: God consoles us in all our affliction so we may be able to console those who are in affliction. For just as Christ's sufferings are abundant for us, so also our consolation is abundant through Christ. Let us bring confession of sin and brokenness before God. People: Merciful God, we stand in need of your healing and transforming presence in our lives. We long for wholeness but too often cannot resist the demands to compartmentalize our lives. We desire true intimacy but are afraid to be transparent, lest others judge and reject us. We want health but don't take care of our bodies and don't give our souls Sabbath rest. We need authentic, loving community but struggle to commit ourselves deeply to others. Forgive us, we pray. Heal us of our shortsightedness, of our self-hatred and denial, of our illusions of control, of the fears and stresses and anxieties that keep us

from living fully as children created in your image. Amen.
